QUICK FACTS: *Bandalore* (IS-PR 463) exemplifies the best of all worlds in terms of turf quality and diverse applications. Rated one of the top varieties in the new 2010 NTEP Trial, *Bandalore* has some of the highest marks for mean turf quality across multiple regions, plus it recuperates well from wear and high traffic situations. Good summer density, retention of quality into the fall, along with some salt tolerance and excellent resistance to brown patch, complete the spectrum of qualities attributed to *Bandalore*.

ADAPTATION: *Bandalore* is an excellent choice for situations where a quality turf is mandatory. Suited for use in landscaping, home lawns, areas of active use such as parks, sports fields and golf course tees and fairways. It can be applied as a straight, mixture, or in blends of compatible species such as Kentucky bluegrass and fine fescues.
