- High overall yield and yield from the first cut
- Good winter-hardiness
- Suitable for loamy soil

AKURAT is a late variety of perennial ryegrass with impressive yield figures, both in its first cut and overall. AKURAT exhibits good rust resistance and persistence. Important factors for sites in northern Germany include its suitability for loamy soil and good sward density. In addition, AKURAT shows high winter-hardiness.
