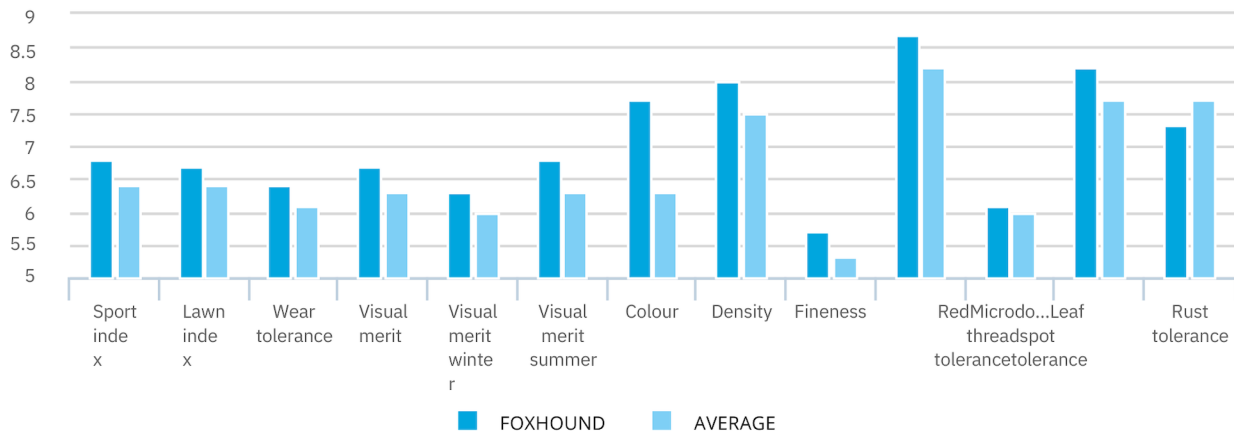

### Multi-Resistant

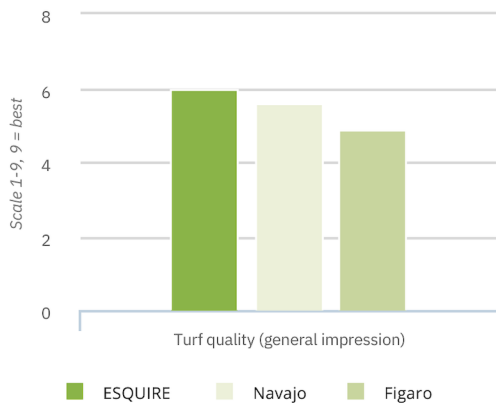

ESQUIRE takes off very early in spring with an impressive density. This explains also a very good wear tolerance. This is combined with good summer appearance and leaf fineness above average.

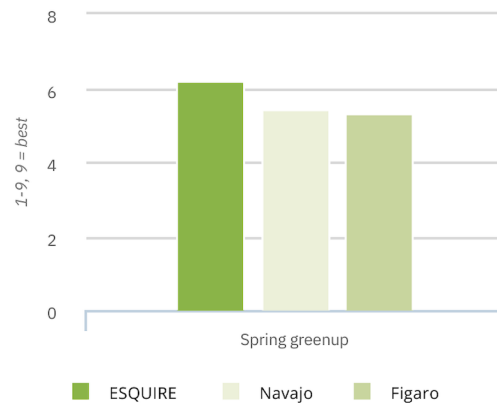

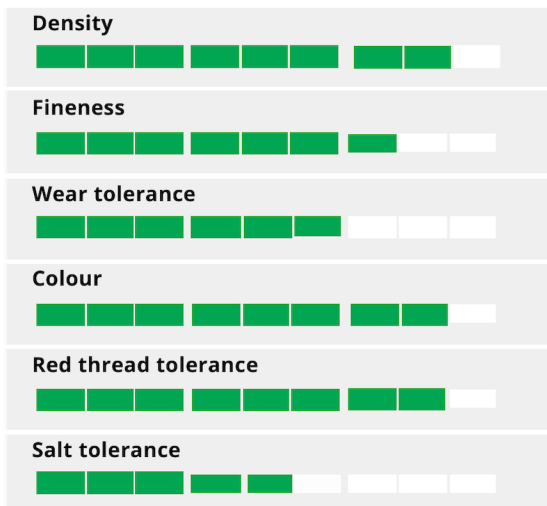

## Fine leaves and dense turf

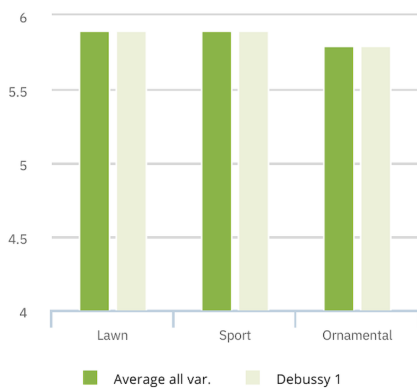
With finer leaves and high density Debussy 1 clearly belongs to the new generation of tall fescues gathering nice appearance and rusticity.

The investment in Debussy 1 pays back for long time due to high persistency and good preservation of visual impression with high disease resistance and wear tolerance.

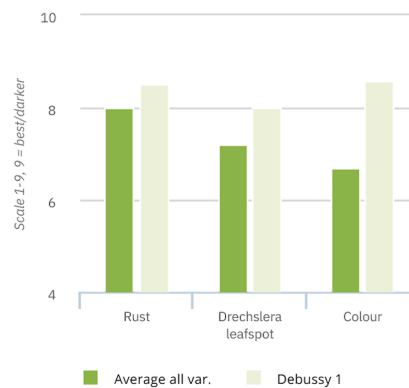
