





**Description**

RIDU produces a dark blue/green fine leaved, low growing turf. It has a quick establishment and a medium-slow growth with an early greening up in spring.

**Resistant and Tolerant**

Rust attack is one of the severe diseases in perennial ryegrass, but do not worry - Greenway can beat it!








**Wood meadow grass**

Mixtures for shade caused by trees, buildings etc. with no or infrequent mowing especially with fine fescues, bent grasses, perennial ryegrass and smooth stalked meadowgrass.
